The following is provided in the spirit of constitutionalism, where an explanation of principles is expected to accompany the statement of rules.

Principles of Engagement

The *Constitutio* website presents an invitation for citizens-who-would-be-makers, and makers-who-would-be-citizens, to think for themselves, constitutionally. For that, it offers a framework — consisting of zones and phases for reflection and reasoning — which aims to provide a theoretical system of thought about the character of the well-ordered community.

Unless otherwise noted, all of the materials and designs (including graphics, visual compositions, color arrays, trademarks, and logos) contained in **www.Constitutio.com** — as well as the scheme of the Website and the layout of the theoretical model of “Colors & Forms” themselves — are the copyrighted intellectual property of **William F.
